A number of Saint Thomas Credit Union members are directly affected by the recent flood. Many have lost possessions and cherished memories. Some have lost much more. Your credit union is founded on a simple concept - "People Helping People", and we are offering several new services to help ease some of the financial stress during this difficult time. They include:

- (1) Those who receive a gift card from the Foundation for flood assistance will also receive an additional \$25 gift card from St. Thomas Credit Union – whether or not they are members. Confidentiality will be maintained by the Foundation.
- (2) Members with current loans that experienced flood damage are eligible for a 90 day loan extension; please apply at the credit union.
- (3) Members are eligible for newly approved low rate financing options to include emergency, vehicle, and appliance loans.
- (4) Members have access to expert assistance to help negotiate price for replacement used vehicles on your behalf. You also may call Jim Clendenning at (615) 337-4915 and set up an appointment for this free service. Additionally, we have a list of auto dealers offering special pricing to St. Thomas Credit Union members.
- (5) The credit union staff will be in the cafeteria on the Saint Thomas Campus on Thursday, May 13, 2010 from 10:00 P.M. to 1:00 A.M. to assist you with any needs. We will also be increasing our presence and availability in Metro Center.
- (6) Computers are available at the White Bridge office for members needing to FEMA or other means of assistance online.
